Jorden and Israel Tour Itinerary

The first step to roaming around Jorden and Israel is booking flights and hotels. Once you arrive, your itinerary is as follows:

Day 1:

Arrive in Amman, Jordan

Cross the border into Israel and visit the ancient city of Jericho, believed to be one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world.

Drive to Jerusalem and explore the Old City, including the Western Wall, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and the colorful markets and alleyways.

In the afternoon, visit Yad Vashem, Israel's official memorial to the victims of the Holocaust.

End the day with a panoramic view of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives.

Overnight in Jerusalem.
